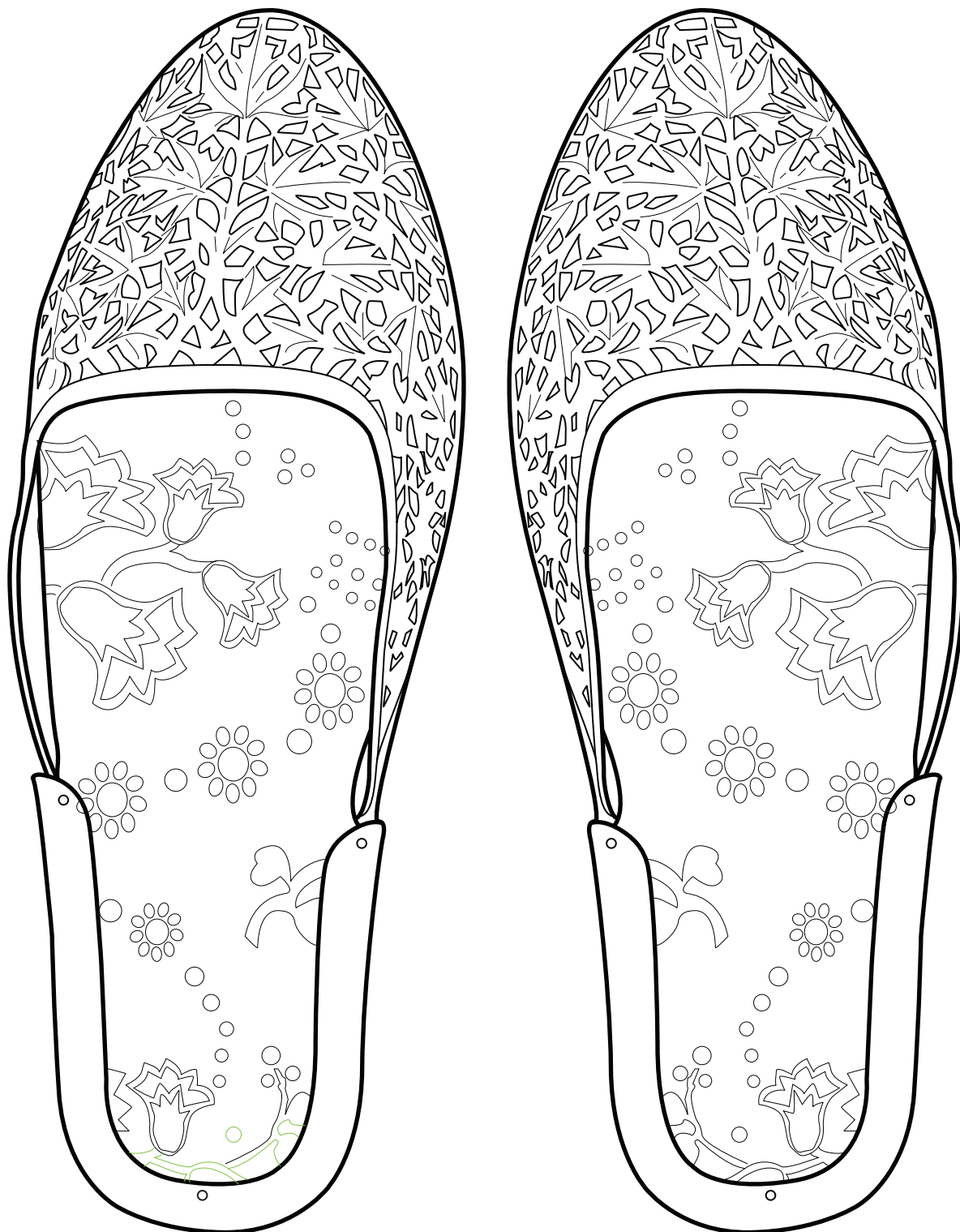


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These silver and gold mules come from India and feature a leaf design known as chinar. It is possible that they were given to a Hindu bride as a gift for her wedding day.
