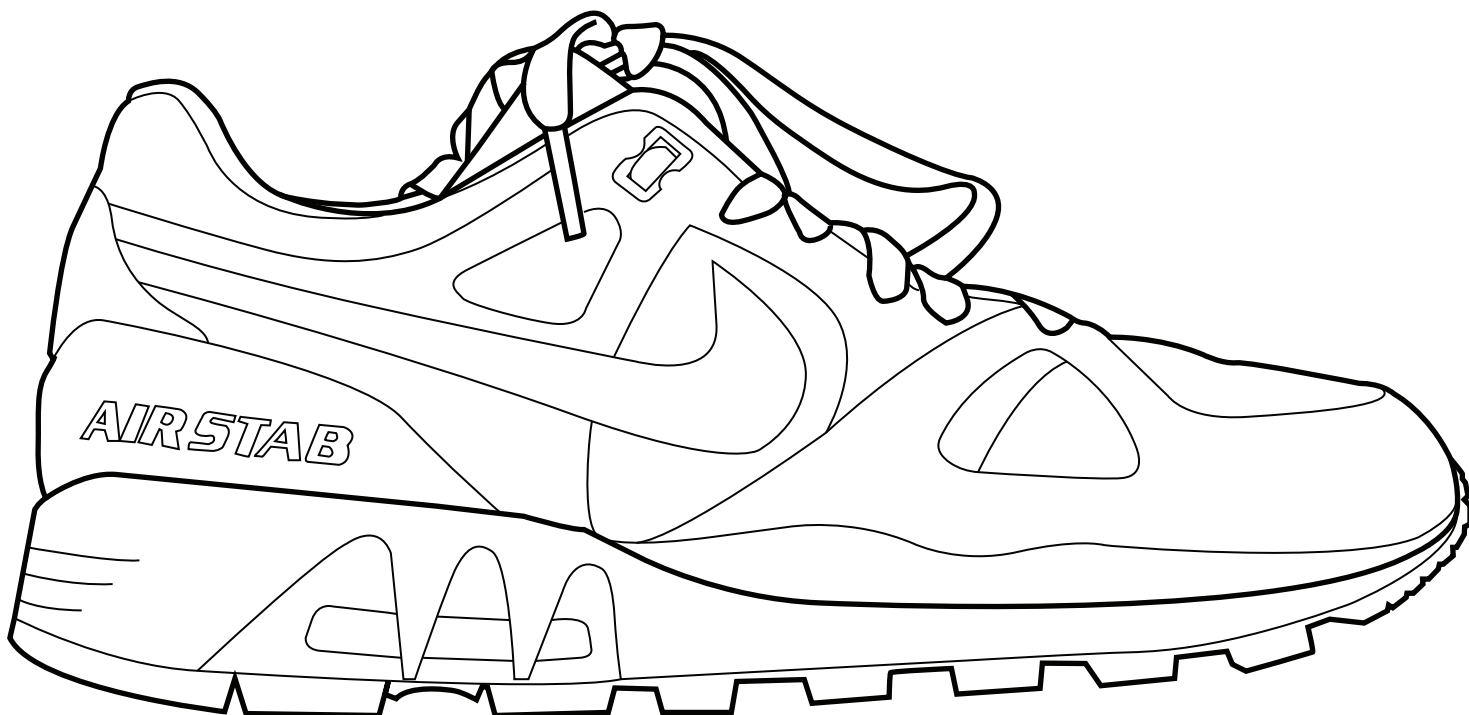


# COLOURING THE WORLD AT YOUR FEET

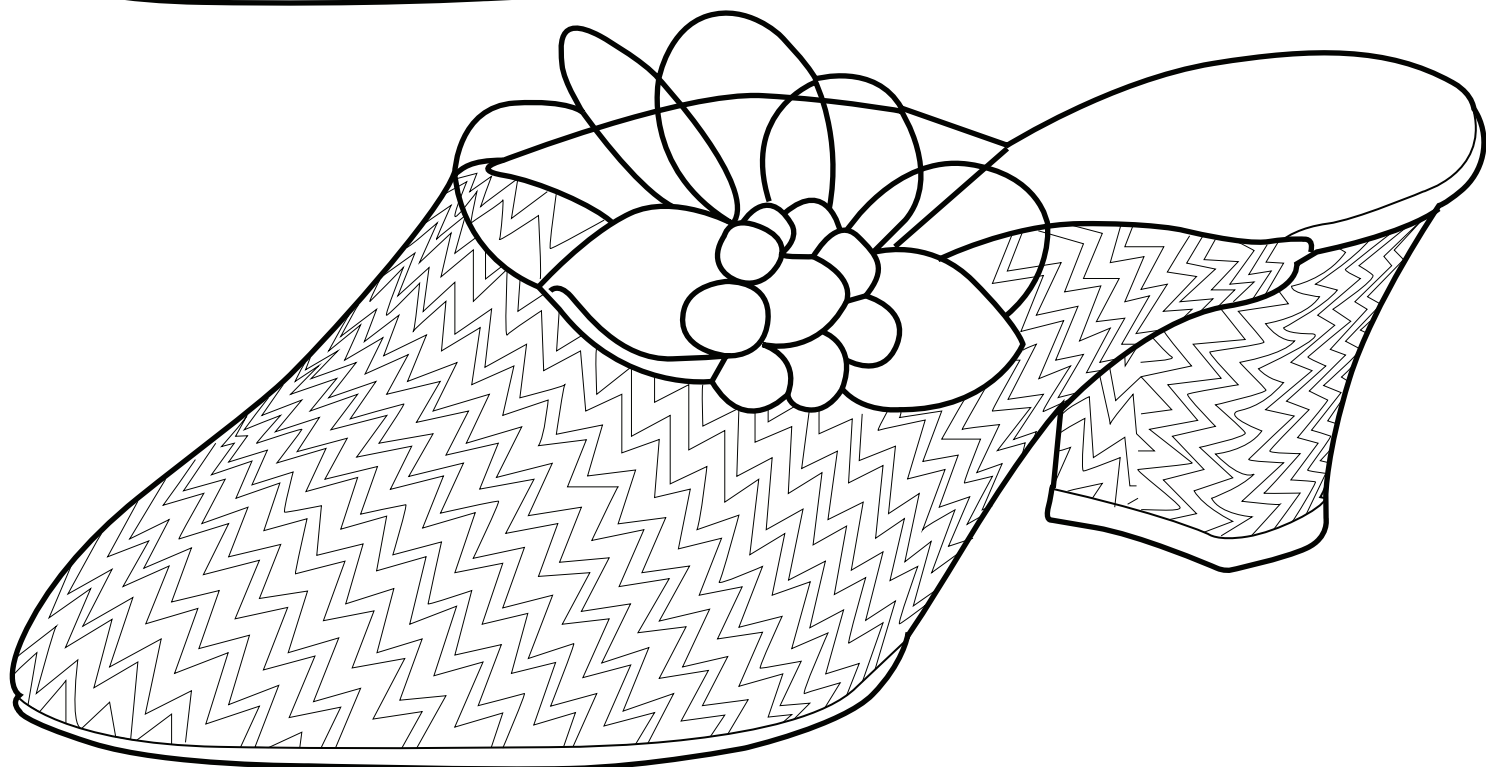
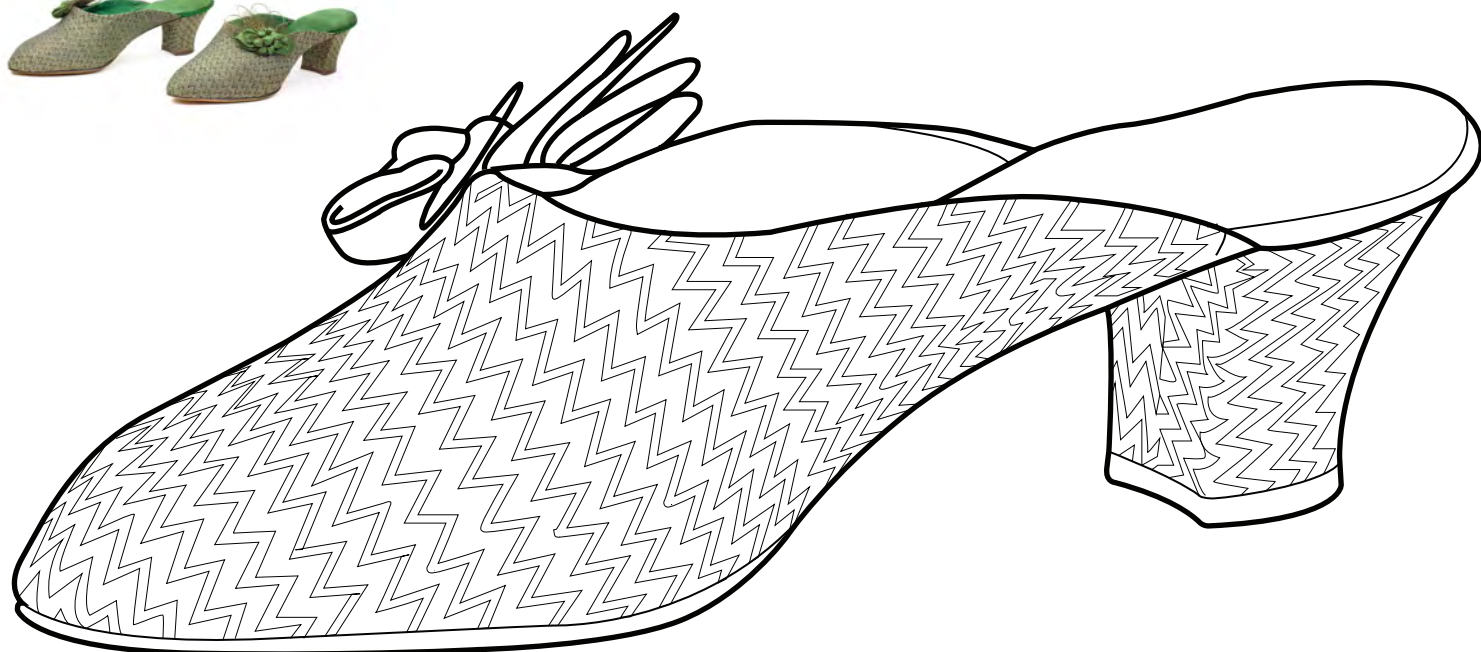
