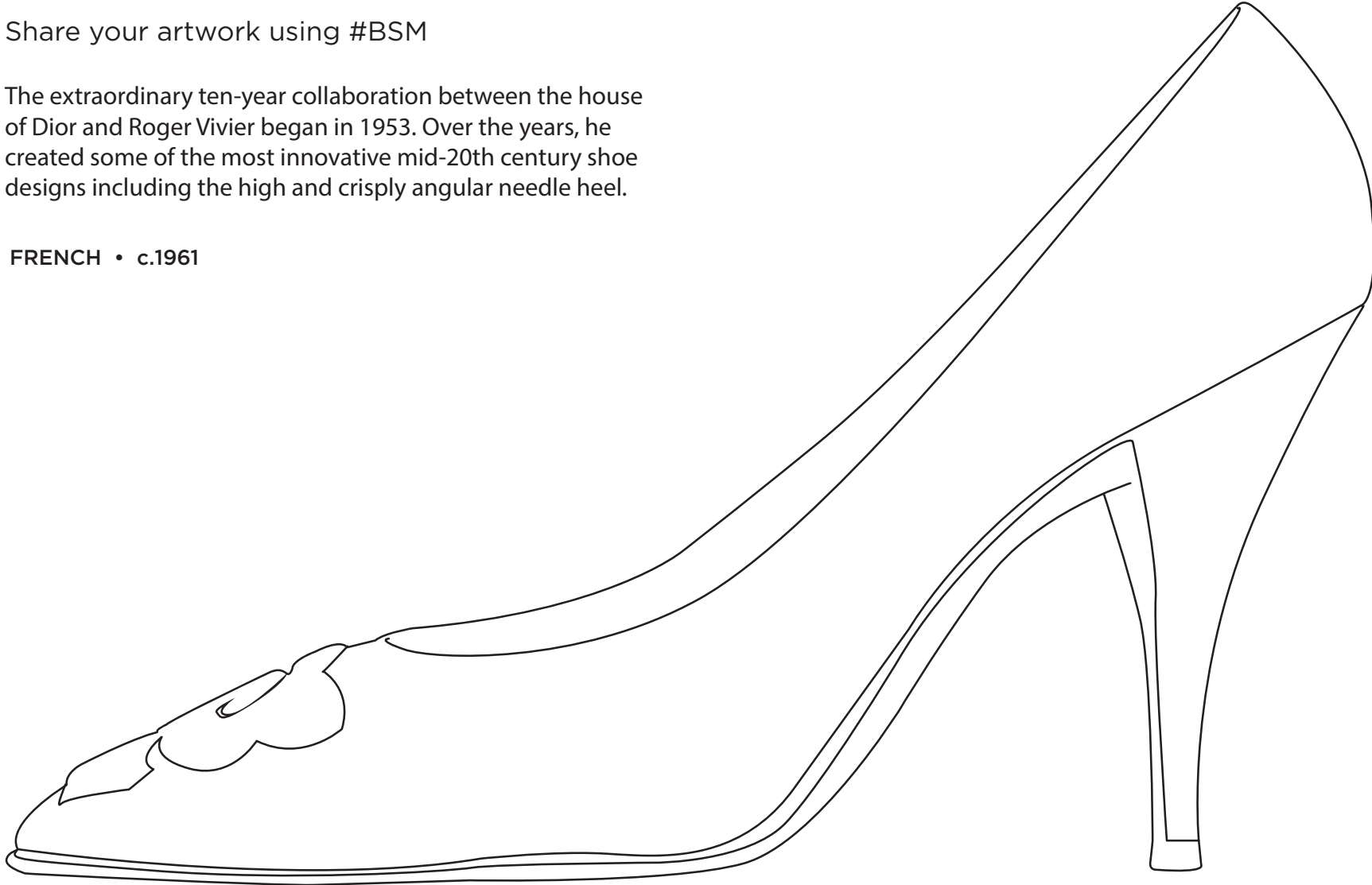


Colouring THE WORLD AT YOUR FEET

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The extraordinary ten-year collaboration between the house of Dior and Roger Vivier began in 1953. Over the years, he created some of the most innovative mid-20th century shoe designs including the high and crisply angular needle heel.

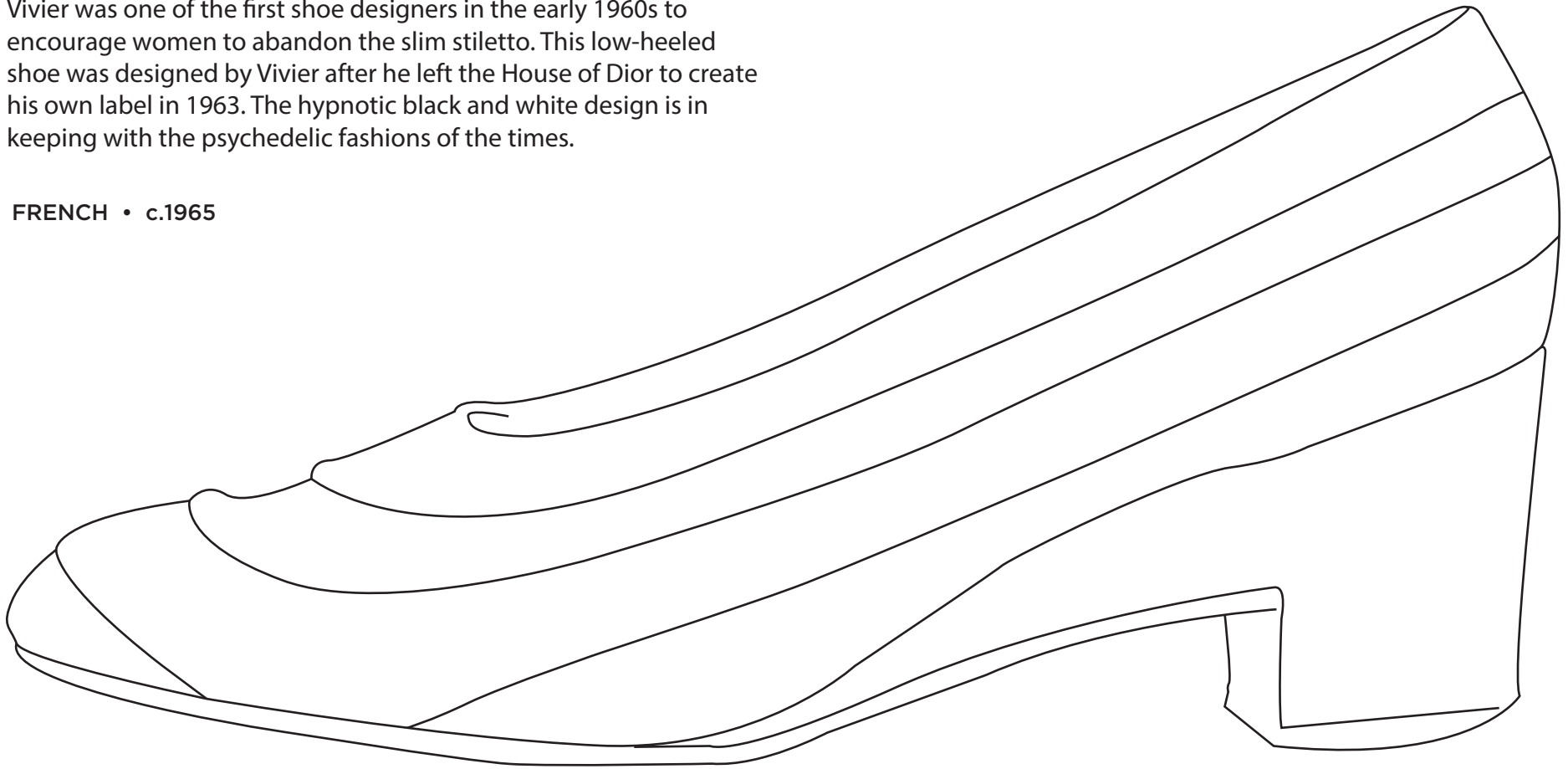
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Vivier was one of the first shoe designers in the early 1960s to encourage women to abandon the slim stiletto. This low-heeled shoe was designed by Vivier after he left the House of Dior to create his own label in 1963. The hypnotic black and white design is in keeping with the psychedelic fashions of the times.
