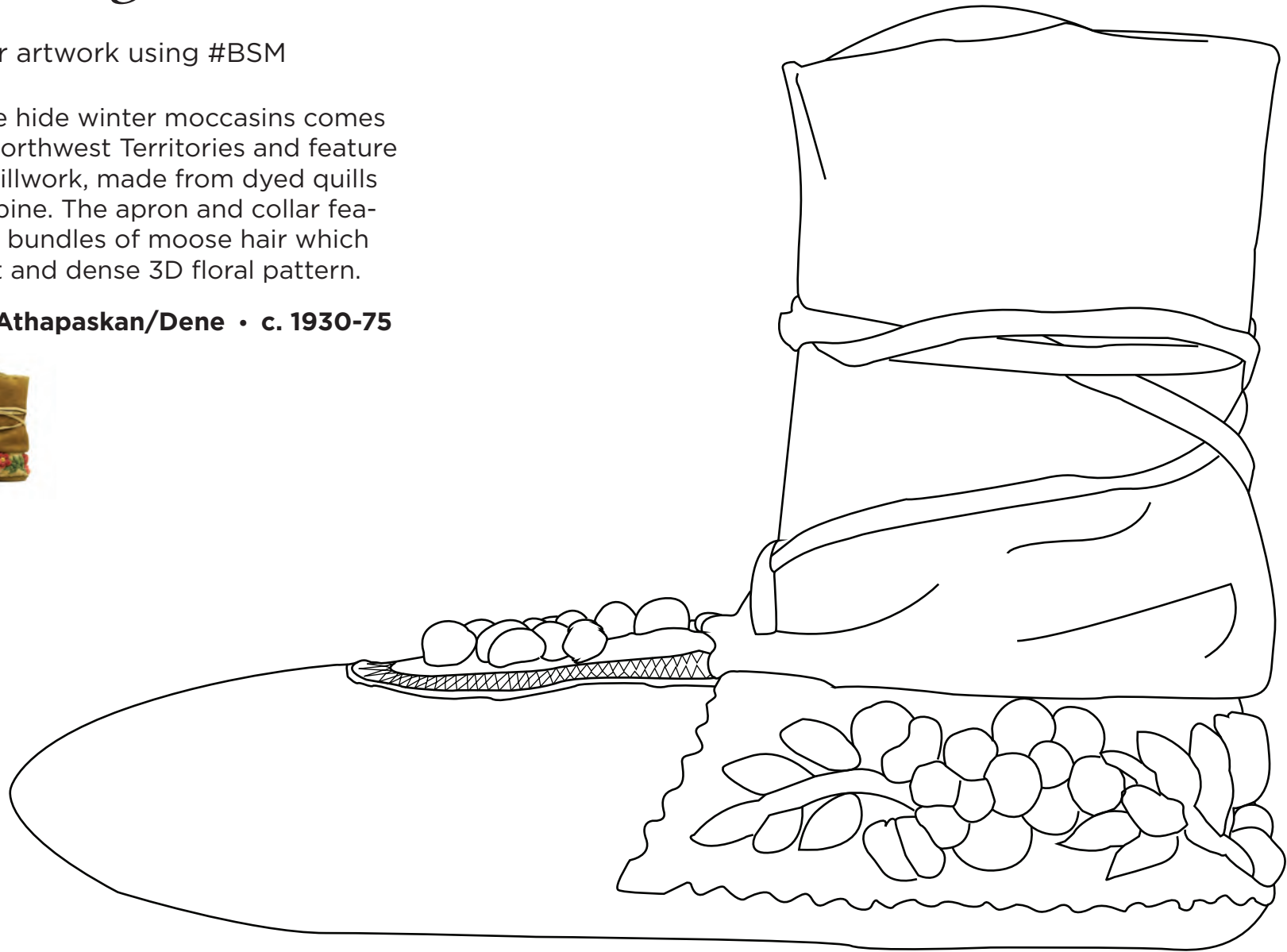


Colouring THE WORLD AT YOUR FEET

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This moose hide winter moccasins comes from the Northwest Territories and feature colorful quillwork, made from dyed quills of a porcupine. The apron and collar feature tufted bundles of moose hair which form a soft and dense 3D floral pattern.

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This soft-soled kamik was made by Sadie Brown from Haines Junction in the Yukon Territory in the late 1980s. It is made of smoked moose hide, warm beaver fur and colorful beads which form eagle designs.
