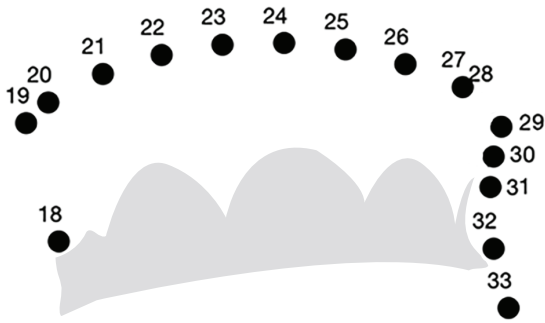
Metohija, early 20th century

This hand-knit pair of traditional women's ankle-length socks comes from the Metohija region of Kosovo. The black wool used to knit these socks is the perfect backdrop for the metallic embroidery and red yarn used at the toe. Red and gold are colours commonly found in Metohija women's fashion.
